Receive a cordial greeting. I hope everything goes well, both on a personal level and in your valuable work at the head of Solidaridad Internacional NGO.


I allow myself to write to you to share an idea that is born from social concern and also from hope. As we well know, in the Dominican Republic there are numerous houses and buildings that are now abandoned that could regain life and meaning if they are put to an adequate and profoundly human use.

From different contacts and solidarity organizations, there is the possibility of channeling donations and support for the habilitation of some of these spaces. The proposal is to transform one of these houses into a shelter for women victims of abuse in a safe, dignified and discreet place, where they can

to find protection, accompaniment and a real opportunity to rebuild their lives.

It would not be a hotel in the commercial sense, but a transitory home, conceived from solidarity and social commitment. In this sense, your experience, your sensitivity and your responsibility as president of Solidaridad Internacional would be key to assessing the feasibility and focus of such a project.

It is not an idea thrown into the air, but an initiative that could be studied calmly, seriously and responsibly, always joining wills and seeking the greatest possible human impact.
